Red Dazzler scores Group 1 Winner

Eureka Stud sire, Red Dazzler scored his first Gr 1 winner with Eureka-homebred 3yo filly, Tinto, taking out the Gr 1 BRC Queensland Oaks (2400m) on Saturday.

The son of Red Ransom, and Gr 1 Toorak Hcp winner, Red Dazzler rolls on having had three stakes winners in the last month, Tinto, Typhoon Red and El Milagro (Singapore).

Tinto (ex Truly Brave by Brave Warrior) was bred and raced by Grania McAlpine, wife of Scott McAlpine, proprietor of Eureka Stud, trained by long-term friend and associate Toowoomba trainer Rex Lipp, and ridden by an ecstatic Tim Bell.

She has now earned \$475,200 in prize money, after being passed in at two sales, for \$12,000 at the 2012 Magic Millions QTIS Yearling Sale and later for \$6,500 at the Magic Millions National Sale.

Eureka Stud and the McAlpine family have been enjoying a great run on the racetrack with home-breds, including a quinella in last weekend's Gr 1 Doomben 10,000 (1,350m) with the half-brothers Spirit Of Boom (Sequalo) and Temple Of Boom (Piccolo). Both bred, reared and raced by Eureka.

Red Dazzler (ex Vain Hill by Danehill), who earned the title of Queensland's Leading First & Second Season Sire (2010-11-12) has

amassed \$5.6million in progeny earnings with 88 individual winners (231 wins).

Standing at a fee of \$6,600 (inc gst) at Eureka Stud in Queensland, Red Dazzler will be partnered this season by the soon to be retired Spirit of Boom, who will stand for \$11,000 (inc gst) to continue the McAlpine family tradition of the past 60 years in standing stallions and raising successful racehorses.

The latest yearling from Truly Brave, a Red Dazzler full brother to Tinto is being presented by Eureka at this week's Magic Millions National Yearling Sale.

The brown colt is catalogued as lot 1889 and he will go under the hammer during the second day of the yearling sale on Thursday.

There are seven yearlings catalogued in the sale by Red Dazzler - five colts and two fillies.
