Kristen Manning Pedigree Analysis

As dam of five individual Gr.1 winners, Eight Carat cemented her place as one of the world's most successful broodmares and her influences continues to be felt via her descendants.

72 of whom are stakes winners, 14 at the elite level.

Meanwhile 35 of her descendants have stood at stud, 20 of those siring stakes winners - 13 represented by Gr.1 winners.

Of her eight Gr.1 winning descendants to stand, all but one have sired stakes winners... and all seven of those horses are Gr.1 sires. Between them... 148 stakes winners, 26 Gr.1 winners.

Another five - including Zed (sire of Verry Elleegant), Deep Field and Commands - are Group winning sires of Gr.1 horses; making Eight Carat the gift that just keeps on giving!

So well named after a world famous diamond, Jonker is poised to be the latest successful Gr.1 winning stallion from this renowned family - one which goes back to another famous matriarch - "The Flying Filly" Mumtaz Mahal, daughter of another great mare in Lady Josephine.

Eight Carat is the obvious starting point when discussing possible line-breeding pattern for Jonker whose dam sire Kempinsky is out of the dual Gr.1 winner Tristalove, daughter of Eight Carat's Gr.1 winner Diamond Lover.

Meaning that his speedy dam Hearts And Arrows is 4 X 4 Eight Carat.

The Gr.1 Blue Diamond winner Daumier is amongst those line-bred to Eight Carat - other success stories including the stakes winners Cifrado, Washington Heights, Altar, Rain Affair, Obsequious, Kaptain Kaos, Whiskey Neat, Amercement, Pin Sec, Rainer, Agent Pippa, Special Reward, Wink And A Nod, Saloon Bar, Kin, Satin Slipper, Bandipur, Peacock, At Witz End, Secret Trail, Stick Seeker, Scream Machine, Executed and Pelicano.

Amongst Jonker's first winners are two with Eight Carat influence - Syrian Diamond having Kaapstad as his second dam sire whilst Heart Of Vienna has Jonker's third dam Wycombe as her fourth dam whilst her dam sire Bramshaw and second dam sire Dangerous (grandson of Diamond Lover) are also members of the Eight Carat clan.



It is of course still early days for Jonker but two two-year-old winners suggests that his Eight Carat influence is shining through.

There are many ways to tap into the family strength; Eight Carat duplications possible via mares by or with Kaapstad (sire of Kaaptive Edition, McFlirt and Simonstad), Octagonal (sire of Lonhro), Don Eduardo (sire of Swift Alliance), Colombia, Dangerous, Court Of Jewels, Force Majeure and Carbonfibre.

Lonhro is worthy of special mention as he has had so many nice sons at stud - such as Encryption, Exosphere, Pierro, Sessions, Impending, Benfica, Demerit, O'Lonhro and Sweeneyse.

Whilst Eight Carat has proven to be a reliable and classy line-breeding subject, her daughter Cotehele House - Jonker's fourth dam - is an even better one.

Eleven of the 78 winners boasting a Cotehele House cross are stakes winners including the star mare Verry Elleegant (her sire and dam both have her as their third dam) and the Group winners Cosmic Force, Fair Trade, Quilate, Belle Detelle, Sky Command, Shooting For Gold, Tailleur and Fiscal Fantasy.

Strains of Cotehele House are most easily found via her sons Commands (sire of Ambidexter, Court Command, Epaulette, Rommel, Skilled, Atomic and Holler) and Danewin (sire of Excites and second dam sire of Extreme Warrior) and her descendants Deep Field (sire of Portland Sky and Cosmic Force; the latter being out of a mare by Commands) and Shooting To Win.

She also appears in Special Bond, Shadow Creek, Dust In The Wind, Dark Lord, Big Jesse, Masterofceremonies and Bramshaw (dam sire of Heart Of Vienna). Meanwhile Tristalove can be duplicated via De Beers and Love A Dane whilst her dam Diamond Lover is in Dangerous (second dam sire of Heart Of Vienna), I Conquer, The Commander, Danelove, Dedline and Ukok Warrior.

Eight Carat's dam Klairessa is another worthy line-breeding subject with her descendants to have stood at stud including Sidereus, Sheer Talent, Telesto, Eire, Kreisler and Lacryma Cristi.

Not only does Jonker carry two Eight Carat strains, but he has a pedigree strongly influenced by the Mumtaz Mahal/Lady Josephine family from which she hails - multiple strains of Fair Trial, Mahmoud, Aristophanes and Nasrullah plus single instances of The Recorder, Royal Charger, Abernant and Jambo.

It is a case of the more the better with this family and highly desirable for Jonker are strains of Nilo, Prince Taj, Pherooshah, Coeur Volant, Kalamoun, Badruddin, Tudor Minstrel, Migoli, Kashmir II, Kurdistan, Adraan, Combat, Faux Tirage, Furrokh Siyar, Lucky Bag, Ardistaan, Test Case, Shergar and Nizami.



There have also been a number of Lady Josephine descendants standing at stud in Australasia in recent times - such as Mossman (Jonker's sire Spirit Of Boom has had six runners out of his daughters; five winners), Nassipour, Golden Snake, Rock Hero, Famous Star, Savoie Vivre, Oarsman, Kbenjar, Walking Or Dancing, Bao Lack and Nediym whose son General Nediym is in the dams of three Spirit Of Boom stakes winners.

And there are several stallions who also have strong Lady Josephine influence such as Pins (dam sire of Spirit Of Boom's stakes winner Sugar Boom), Rory's Jester (in three Spirit Of Boom stakes winners), Bel Esprit (dam sire of seven Spirit Of Boom runners; six winners), Love Conquers All, Rebel Dane, Star Turn, Rubiton (in 16 Spirit Of Boom runners; 12 winners including two stakes winners), Wootton Bassett, Toorak Toff, Swear, Spill The Beans, Sizzling, Royal Meeting, Reset, Magnus and All Too Hard. As well as four Champion Sires... Written Tycoon, Zoustar, I Am Invincible and Redoute's Choice.

Written Tycoon matches up very nicely with Jonker boasting three strains of the wonderful mare Oceana - her sons Noholme II, Faringdon and Todman. Written Tycoon (grandsire of the stakes winner Rich On Bubbles out of a Spirit Of Boom mare) meanwhile is bred on a 7 X 7 cross of Oceana's dam Orama via another Noholme II strain plus Nearula.

Spirit Of Boom picks up well on the Oceana influence - Jonker one of his five stakes winners carrying a Todman strain whilst five have further Noholme II. All seven of his runners out of mares with Faringdon are winners and it is also worth seeking out Oceana's other son Shifnal; not easy to find (in three Spirit Of Boom runners; two winners) but he does pop up in Skilled and Ambidexter (full brothers by Cotehele House's son Commands) and their half-brother Sidestep.

Jonker's first city winner Novelty has River Rough as his second dam sire - and that horse is a grandson of Noholme.

Also of interest are mares by Flying Artie (his dam is 5 X 4 Oceana via Todman and Noholme II), Savabeel (his grandam is 4 X 4 Oceana via Noholme II and Todman), Savabeel's son Cool Aza Beel (line-bred to the Rough Shod family mentioned below), Strasbourg (has two strains of Todman and is a descendant of Oceana) and Starspangledbanner (his dam sire Made Of Gold is a great grandson of Noholme whilst his third dam sire Zamazaan is from the same Rose O'Lynn family as Special Dane's third dam sire Venture).

Back to Written Tycoon - mares by his sons Winning Rupert, Dirty Work, Rich Enuff and Ole Kirk offer further Lady Josephine strength whilst Written By allows for a cross of Miswaki supported by strain of that stallion's relation Tobougg. And his grandson Captivant (out of a Commands mare) is from the same family as Thatch (see notes below).



Zoustar mares are also of particular interest as are those by his sire Northern Meteor (sire of Deep Field and Shooting To Win) - a horse bred on a 6 X 4 cross of his own fourth dam Rough Shod II; also grandam of Thatch to whom Spirit Of Boom is line-bred 4 X 5 (noting that one of those strains in Thatching is bred on a 4 X 5 cross of his own fifth dam Dalmary, dam of Rough Shod II).

And Northern Meteor has excellent Lady Josephine strength.

His family is one of the world's most best to line-breed to and strains are easily found... namely Sadler's Wells (great grandsire of the dam of Jonker's first city winner Novelty who also hails from this great family), Perugino (second dam sire of Novelty), Fairy King (sire of Encosta de Lago), Nureyev, Lorenzaccio (also appears in Novelty), Ridan and Lt Stevens. Other stallions from this family include Captivant, Smart Missile, Fiorente, Headwater and Sir Prancealot.

Zoustar is out of a mare by Redoute's Choice, in turn out of a mare by Canny Lad. Canny Lad, whose grandam is bred on a close 3 X 3 cross of Dodoma (daughter of Eight Carat's influential fifth dam Mumtaz Begum) has combined very well with Spirit Of Boom in the pedigrees of 87 winners including five stakes winners.

Also out of a Canny Lad mare is I Am Invincible (sire of stakes winner Hi Barbie out of a Spirit Of Boom mare) - descendant of the influential Paraffin.

Multiple strains of that mare are a strength of Jonker's pedigree. She is ancestress of both Spirit Of Boom and his sire Sequalo as well as of the great mare Chelandry to whom Jonker is line-bred to via Never Say Die and Clarion.

I Am Invincible (whose sire Invincible Spirit hails from the same family as Rockefeller, Bletchingly, Danzig and Sicambre who all feature in Jonker... and whose grandsire Green Desert is from the same Betty Derr family as Semipalatinsk's dam sire Reverse) is a descendant of Chelandry (as is his second dam sire Zoffany) and he picks up strongly on her influence.

Overshare (has Sadler's Wells from Thatch's family), Kobayashi, Home Affairs (has Nureyev from Thatch's family), Barbaric, North Pacific (grandam is by Eight Carat's son Octagonal) and Tassort are other I Am Invincible line horses with further Lady Josephine family strength whilst Strasbourg and I Am Immortal also match up well.

Other members of the Paraffin family include High Chaparral, Anabaa, Zeditave, Alannon, Rory's Jester, Shamardal, Speak John, Arch Sculptor, Drone, Stage Door Johnny, El Prado, Mummy's Pet, Panorama, Gold Carat, Bellotto, Forty Niner and Street Cry (and his son Street Boss).



Members of the Street Cry line are of special interest for Jonker, that stallion's Epsom & Irish Derby winning dam sire Troy being a son of the multiple Gr.1 winner Petingo whose dam Quarterdeck is the third dam of Spirit Of Boom's grandsire Rustic Amber. This family can also be found in mares by California Dane (sire of Rebel Dane).

In regards to Street Cry's sons the best matches for Jonker are daughters of Street Boss (Lady Josephine strength - and a rare strain of the Kentucky Derby winner Iron Liege whose dam Iron Maiden is the grandam of Reverse; dam sire of Spirit Of Boom's second dam sire Semipalatinsk), Pride Of Dubai, Telperion (has Nureyev) and Per Incanto (his dam hails from the Lorenzaccio sire line).

Jonker's closest line-breeding is his 4 X 3 cross of Danehill (via Special Dane and Kempinsky), a horse who combines exceptionally well with his close relations Northern Dancer (his grandsire), Halo and Machiavellian (sire of Street Cry).

Jonker is one of his sire's 17 stakes winners line-bred to Danehill; Spirit Of Boom doing well with Red Dazzler (out of a Danehill mare), Fastnet Rock, Commands (son of Cotehele House), Flying Spur, Exceed And Excel, Conatus and Excites (by Cotehele House's son Danewin).

All but one of Jonker's first five winners have further Danehill... via Red Dazzler, Rock Of Gibraltar, Dangerous (grandson of Diamond Lover), Flying Spur and Danzero. Danehill's dam sire His Majesty is a son of the terrific mare Flower Bowl whose high class 3/4 brother Your Host is the dam sire of Noble Decree, dam sire of Jonker's second dam sire Papal Power - giving him a cross of the influential mare Boudoir II.

Further strains of this family are desirable - such as Crowned Prince, Whiskey Road, Majestic Prince and His Majesty's full brother Graustark.

Stallions from this family to have stood locally include Brave Smash (has Kalamoun from the Mumtaz Begum family) and Admire Mars.

Jonker carries three strains of the classy race and broodmare Teresina. Spirit Of Boom's dam sire Special Dane is a descendant and is bred on a 6 X 6 cross with the other strain being her champion sire son Alibhai. Meanwhile Jonker's second dam sire Papal Power is out of a granddaughter of Vaguely Noble whose sire Vienna is out of a mare by her grandson Turkhan. It is worth seeking further strains - not easily done but she is also the third dam of Pakistan II (second dam sire of O'Reilly) and ancestress of American Pharoah's grandsire Empire Maker.

Four of the 52 winners from 67 runners (an excellent 77.6% strike rate) by Spirit Of Boom out of mares with Red Ransom are stakes winners... and the first Jonker runner with a strain is the easy maiden winner Hold My Hand.



Red Ransom combines well with his relation Showdown (to whom three of Spirit Of Boom's stakes winners are line-bred), second dam sire of Sequalo. Spirit Of Boom has shown a particular affinity with Red Dazzler (second dam sire of Hold My Hand) whilst other Red Ransom strains likely to suit Jonker are All American (his dam is a granddaughter of Whiskey Road), Red Element (his grandam is a granddaughter of Lorenzaccio), Onemorenomore (his second dam sire Kenmare is by Mumtaz Begum's descendant Kalamoun), Arlington (his grandam is line-bred to Oceana) and Roc de Cambes (son of a Fairy King mare).

Another member of the Democratie family from which Showdown and Red Ransom hail is Agnes World - and he is the dam sire of Better Than Ready, in turn dam sire of Jonker's impressive debut winner Block The Lead.

Better Than Ready's sire More Than Ready hails from the same Prunella family as Paraffin whilst his second dam sire Keltrice is a grandson of Mumtaz Begum's descendant Kalamoun. And More Than Ready's sire Southern Halo (by Danehill's relation Halo) is from the same Lea Lark family as Miswaki, sire of Jonker's grandam Villa Igea.

Seven of Spirit Of Boom's stakes winners carry a cross of the Kentucky Oaks heroine Lalun, one of the great modern day line-breeding forces. Her son Never Bend is the grandsire of Sequalo's dam and strains of her other son Bold Reason are easily found - most prevalently as the dam sire of Sadler's Wells and Fairy King. Jonker's winners Heart Of Vienna and Hold My Hand also have Bold Reason; both through Fairy King's son Encosta de Lago (noting that his dam sire Star Way is from the same great Selene family as Kempinsky's dam sire Sir Tristram).

Meanwhile five of Spirit Of Boom's stakes winners are line-bred to Without Fear (his third dam sire) and four to Without Fear's Epsom Oaks winning dam Never Too Late whose son Head Over Heels stood in Queensland. As did Semipalatinsk who is duplicated in the pedigrees of five of Spirit Of Boom's stakes winners.

Jonker boasts a couple of Sir Gaylord strains, that horse loves the presence of his legendary half-brother Secretariat (the wonderful mare Somethingroyal duplicated). Another nice mare to line-breed to is Serena whose great great grandson Arctic Explorer is the dam sire Jonker's second dam sire Imposing. She can be found in Desert Prince, Lion Hunter and Prego.
